

## **WATERSHED PROJECT INTERN NEEDED**

The Chippewa River Watershed Project (CRWP) is accepting applications for a summer intern. The CRWP is a grant based partnership with goals of improving water quality in the Chippewa River and its tributaries in western Minnesota. The Chippewa River Watershed Project works towards this goal through awareness building, monitoring and implementation activities.

**Where:** Chippewa River Watershed Project  
Montevideo, MN

**When:** Summer of 2007 (12 weeks). Flexible start date of mid-May.  
Possibility of temporary employment beyond the 12 weeks.

**What:** This is a seasonal environmental internship. Internship responsibilities include but are not limited to grab sample collection for lab analysis, stream flow measurements, stream transparency data collection, assisting with data analysis, macroinvertebrate sampling and identification, shoreline restoration, and public education activities.

**Who Should Apply:** Individuals pursuing degrees in Environmental Studies/Science, Biology, Hydrology, Soil and Water Conservation or related fields. Coursework in biology, chemistry, or hydrology preferred. Individuals must be responsible, highly motivated and able to work independently as most fieldwork will be done with limited supervision. Applicant will be expected to work outdoors, sometimes in adverse conditions and perform some physical labor duties. The ability to accurately collect and record data is essential. Applicant must possess a current driver's license. Applicant must be willing to complete a background check.
