



Tutoring, Reading, and Enabling Children

Come support literacy development by participating in these TREC programs. Opportunities exist for volunteer and work study experiences in school day and after school programs including:

- **TREC In-Class Tutoring**—Assist classroom teachers at the elementary and high school level during the regular school day through tutoring activities designed to support students' literacy development
- **TREC Zone**—Provide tutoring to elementary students during an extended day program from 3:15-5:25 each day of the week; assist with homework, reading, writing, math, and computer skills
- **High School Study Lounge**—Provide tutoring for 7-12th grade students after school from 3:10-5:30 Monday through Friday
- **Storytime at the Library**—Read aloud and engage preschool students in literacy activities Thursday mornings from 10:30-11:15 at the Morris Public Library
- **Intergenerational Literacy**—Read to and engage in discussion of texts with senior citizens and West Wind Village residents
- **TREC at Willmar**—Teach literacy skills to intermediate level elementary school students in a two week summer workshop in Willmar, MN
